Marie Curie discovered two new chemical elements – radium and polonium. She carried out the first research into the treatment of tumors with radiation, and she was the founder of the Curie Institutes, which are important medical research centers.

Irene Joliot-Curie -- Lived 1897 – 1956

Irène Joliot-Curie discovered how to synthesize ‘designer’ radioactive elements in the laboratory. Such elements are now used in tens of millions of medical procedures every year. Their use has saved millions of lives.

The daughter of Marie Curie, Irène followed in her mother’s footsteps, winning a Nobel Prize in Chemistry.
